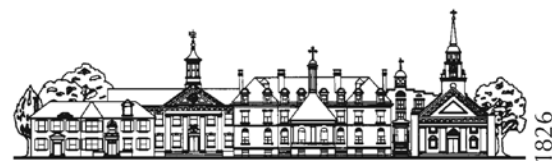

We will examine the power of communally-held memories and consider how these get transmitted in our institutions, schools, churches, families, and neighborhoods, and the influence they carry in shaping our lives. Events on Tuesday revolve around narratives that help form our relationships with our alma mater, its faculty, and one another as alumni/ae and colleagues. On Wednesday, the focus will shift to our roles as leaders and story-brokers in our congregations and communities. Christopher Hedges' lecture will inaugurate and celebrate the Theodore F. Schneider Fund for Homiletics. Nelson Strobert will preside at the opening Eucharist, with Theodore Schneider preaching. Marty Stevens will unpack some scripts within familiar scriptures, reminding us that it's rarely, if ever, "your grandmother's bible." Kathryn Vitalis Hoffman will lead the discussion of the implications of all the presentations for ministry in local settings.
