NOTE: **Part-Time** student cost per credit hour is \$525 less a \$100 per credit hour scholarship for the first 3 credit course and \$200 per credit hour for every course thereafter up to 12 credit hours for ELCA and certain other students. (See INTRODUCTION, p.3, Financial Aid Handbook)  
Full-Time ELCA applicants and certain other students receive a minimum \$2,000 scholarship that will be **COMBINED** with all other institutional scholarship awards per year upon timely completion of the Seminary Financial Aid In-house Application.

The median amount of both need and non-need scholarship aid from Federal, State or local governments or the institution is \$6,595. (from 2009/2010 data)
